Grade 3's- Level 2 or 3 questions using the number 138. | <p>Math</p> <p>What time is it now? Write down the time. What time will it be in 30 minutes? What time was it 20 minutes ago? What time will it be in one hour?</p> | <p>Math</p> <p>Skip count by 3's from 1 to 100. What patterns do you see?</p> <p>(ex: 3,6,9 etc)</p> |

Don't forget to add labels to name the items in your model (i.e. 'My house,' 'Park,' 'The Mailbox,' etc.)</p> | <p>Science! Grow your own crystals! Each player takes a turn at throwing the sockball into the bucket. When a player scores, they must take a step back and throw again until they miss. The player who shoots the ball in the bucket from the farthest distance wins.</p> |
